- The purchase of a recreational permit is required to access any of our tree farms in North Washington.
- Permit Areas include: **Pe Ell North, Pe Ell South, Aberdeen and Vail**
- A limited number of permits are available each year, they are good for one year from August through July, and go on sale in May.

- Fire Season is April 15-October 15, No fires are allowed during this time.

- No ATV, ORV's, Side by Sides (except with a motorized premium permit), Motorcycles or motor-assisted bicycles
